# Sites Reservoir Final Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement (Final EIR/EIS)

The Sites Project Authority and Bureau of Reclamation have prepared a Final EIR/EIS to analyze the potential environmental impacts of construction and operation of the Sites Reservoir Project. As the final step of the environmental review process, the Sites Project Authority will consider the environmental impacts and mitigation measures in deciding whether to carry out the Sites Reservoir Project. The environmental document will go to the Sites Project Authority Board of Directors at its November 17, 2023, Board Meeting.
