This <u>searchable database</u> contains an extensive compendium of numeric water quality thresholds from the literature for over 860 chemical constituents and water quality parameters. Included are:

- California and Federal Drinking Water Standards (MCLs)
- California Public Health Goals (PHGs)
- California State Notification and Response Levels for Drinking Water
- Health Advisories, Water Quality Advisories, and Drinking Water Advisories
- Suggested No-Adverse-Response Levels (SNARLs)
- Cancer Risk Estimates
- Health-based criteria from USEPA Integrated Risk Information System (IRIS)
- Proposition 65 Safe Harbor Levels
- California Toxics Rule Criteria to Protect Human Health and Aquatic Life
- California Ocean Plan Water Quality Objectives
- " USEPA Recommended Criteria to Protect Human Health and Aquatic Life
- → Agricultural Use Protective Limits
- Taste and Odor Based Criteria

These thresholds may be used to assess whether beneficial uses of surface water or groundwater are likely to be impaired or threatened.

The information in the Water Quality Goals database is current as of September 9, 2011.

Explains, with examples, how the numeric thresholds in the Water Quality Goals database may be used to assess whether beneficial uses of water resources are impaired or threatened. A summary of relevant statutes, regulations, plans, and policies and links to original references are included.

Provides basic and essential training on the topic of water quality standards – beneficial uses, water quality objectives, promulgated water quality criteria, water quality control plans and policies that affect allowable concentrations in water. Familiarizes the user with the Water Quality Goals staff report, the searchable online database, four assessment threshold selection algorithms, and how these tools may be used to assess whether beneficial uses of surface water or groundwater are likely to be impaired or threatened. Assessment Thresholds Table (MS Excel format)

Based on the Assessment Threshold Algorithms in the <u>Water Quality Goals Staff Report</u>, this table presents numeric thresholds recommended to implement selected water quality objectives and promulgated water quality criteria, as well as assessment thresholds recommended to protect specified beneficial uses in groundwater, inland surface waters, enclosed bays and estuaries, and ocean waters.
