Although they are free-ranging, and although the map of the hunt zone for the East Park Reservoir sub-herd overlaps with several Primary Study Area facilities, Tule elk have not been documented within the Primary Study Area.

Map of East Park Reservoir sub-herd hunt zone (provided by Joe Hobbs) was compared to the map of the Primary Study Area to determine that the hunt zone overlaps with the northern half of the footprint of the proposed Sites Reservoir, as well as with the Stone Corral, Peninsula Hills, and Saddle Dam recreation areas, Funks Reservoir, Holthouse Reservoir, most roads (excluding Sulphur Gap, Com, and Lurline roads), and portions of the Delevan Pipeline and Tehama-Colusa and GCID Main canals. Herd numbers cited were based on the most recent elk management plan that Joe Hobbs had access to.
