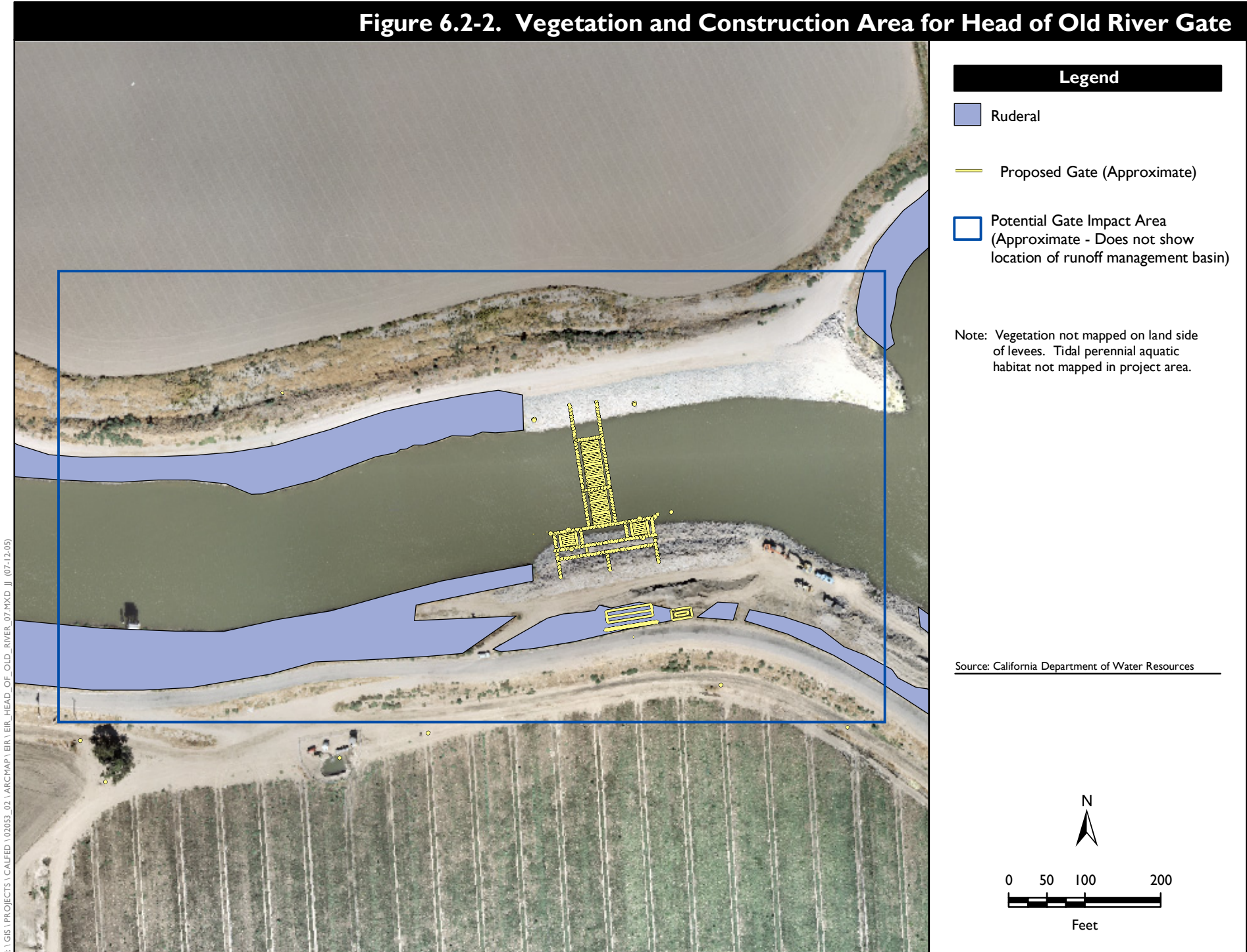
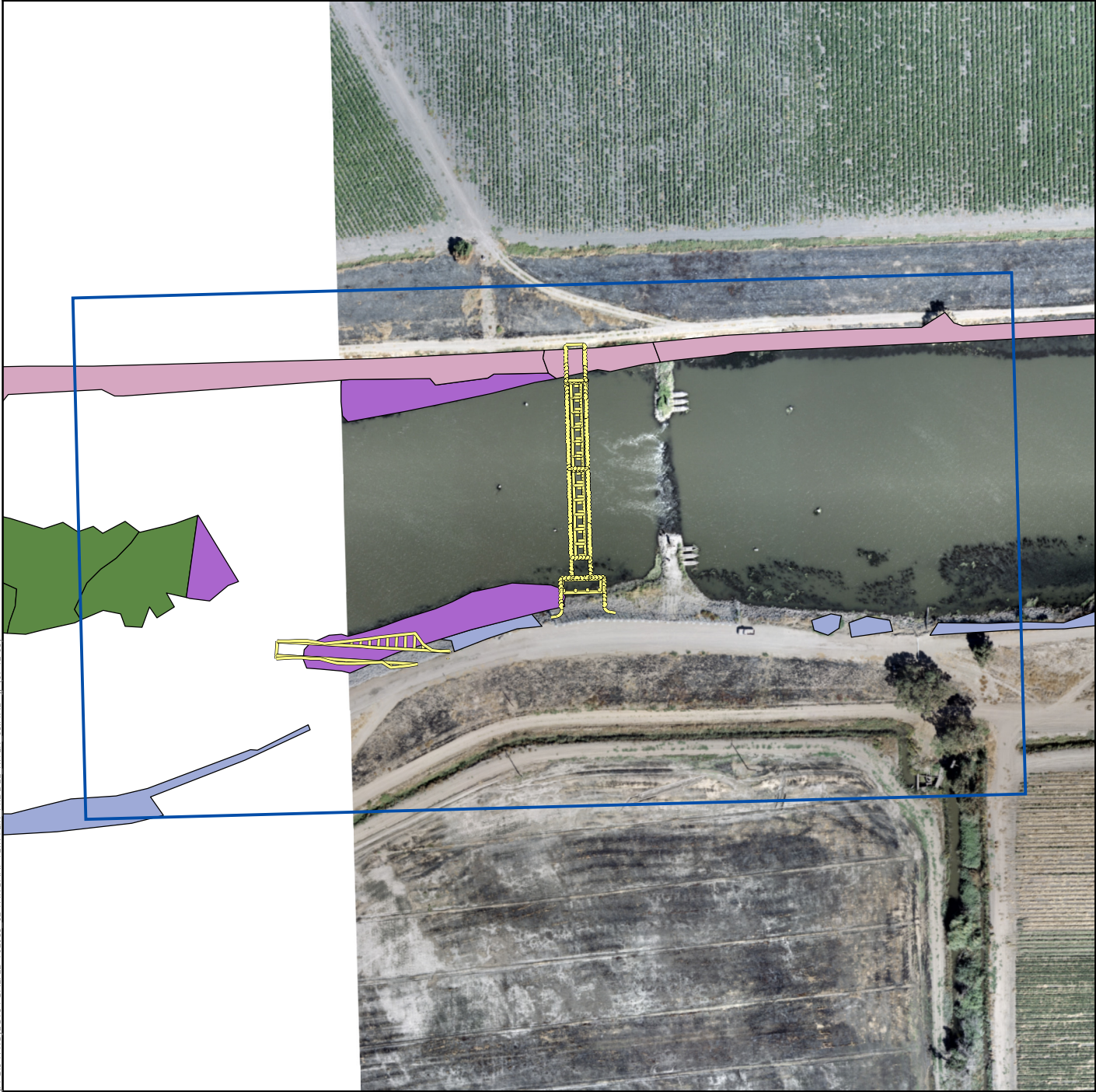


Figure 6.2-2. Vegetation and Construction Area for Head of Old River Gate








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Figure 6.2-3. Vegetation and Construction Area for Middle River Gate

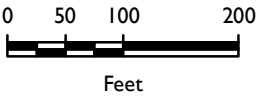

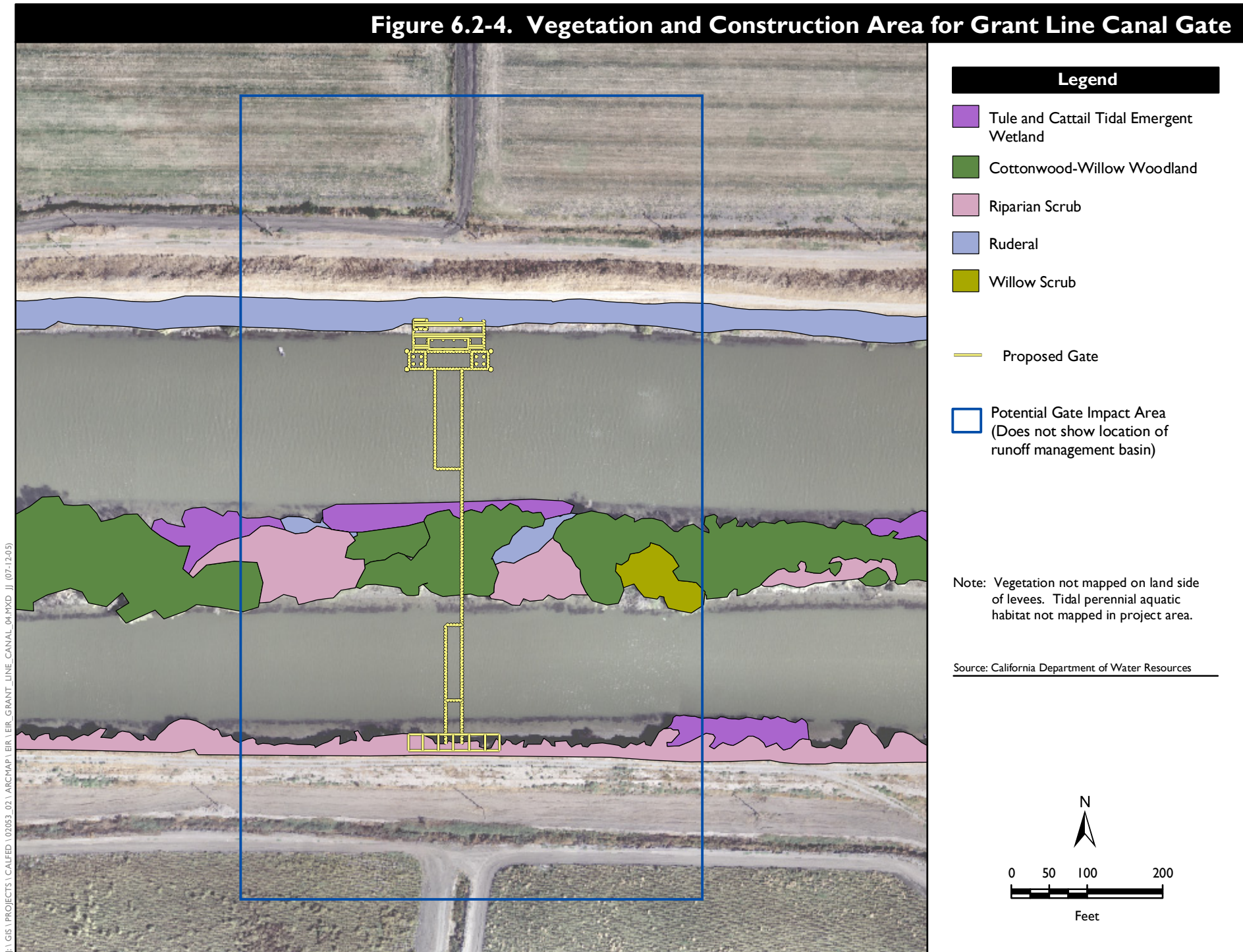

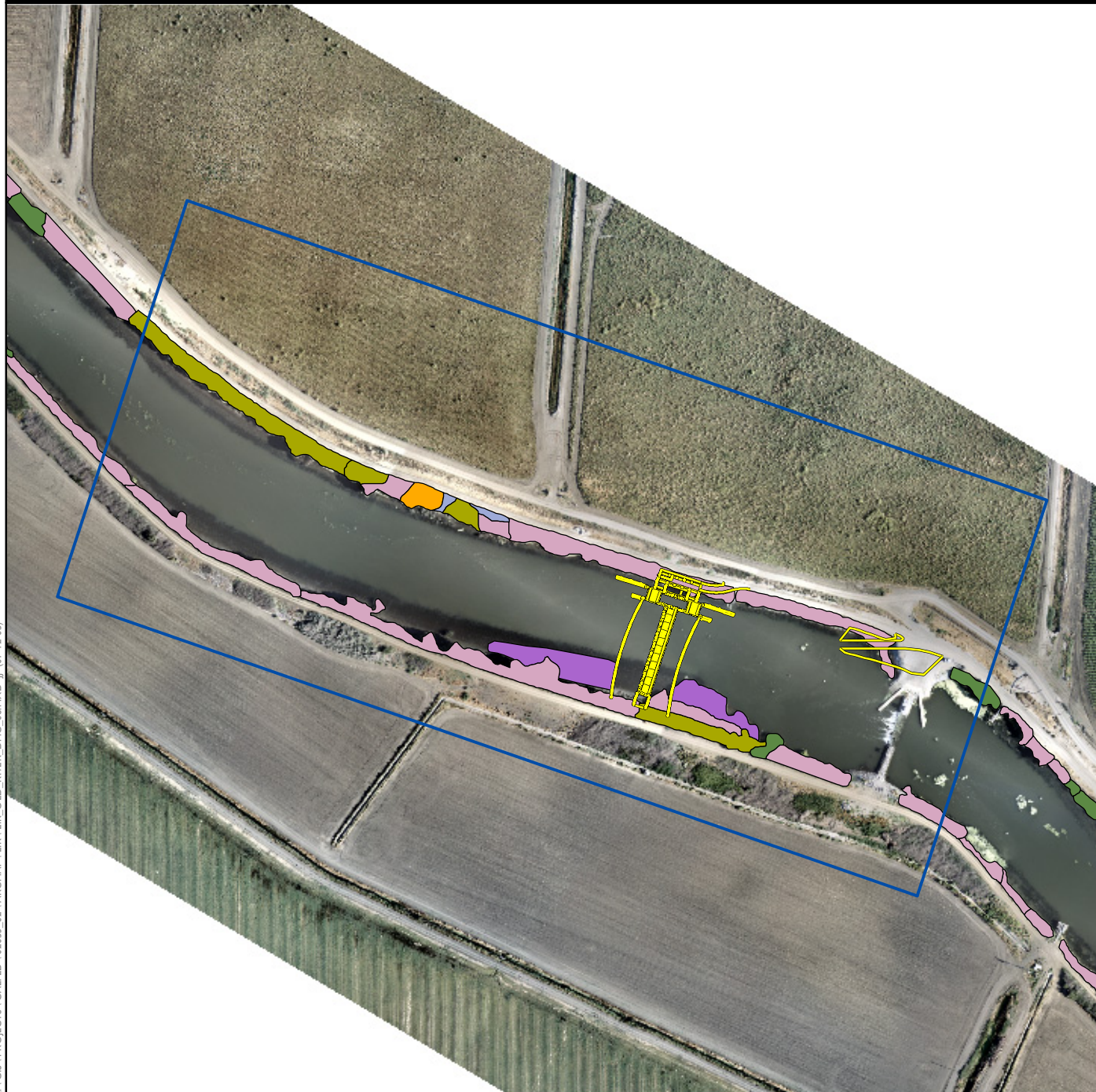

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Figure 6.2-5. Vegetation and Construction Area for Old River at DMC Gate

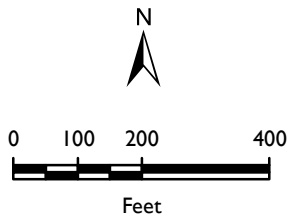
