Maxwell Unified continues to have a route up through Stonyford, and there are no plans to discontinue that service.

The East Park numbers are not currently available. The County recently acquired management of recreation at the reservoir.

Good afternoon Mike,

I apologize for the delayed response, I was working on gathering all of the outstanding information we have related to Colusa County. I have the following requests if you know any of the information or who to track down for it:

- Is the number of annual users of the County’s public transportation system recorded? [Are you asking about vehicle trips on public roads or regional mass transit use?](#) [Regional mass transit. We currently have the following statement:](#)

Nine vehicles comprise the Colusa County Transit services fleet. The services include:

- Five routes operated on a fixed route and schedule. Pick-ups are arranged on a dial-a-ride basis, with door-to-door service available for ADA passengers.
- Out-of-county medical transportation service provided to Chico, Davis, Lincoln, Marysville, Oroville, Roseville, Sacramento, Willows, Woodland, and Yuba City.
- Trips to/from Yuba City provided on Fridays (bus departs Colusa at 9:30 a.m. and departs Yuba City at 1:30 p.m.).
- Charter trips can be arranged using the available fleet if it does not interfere with regularly scheduled service.

[We received a comment that requests: “How many users utilize these services annually?”](#)

- Is information on school bus routes within the County available? [Yes, specify geographic area and we’ll be able to provide the routes. We have the primary roadways used for each of the four districts in the county as follows:](#)
