

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12. Legal Description of Facility:

Northern half of Section 31, Township 30 N, Range 4W, Mount Diablo Base Meridian and a portion of the southern one half of Section 31. The latitude and longitude of the center of the property are 122° 21'34" and 40°25'00", respectively.

13. Findings:

- a. This permit is consistent with the Shasta County Integrated Waste Management Plan, which was approved by the CIWMB on October 22, 1997. The location of the facility is identified in the Countywide Siting Element, pursuant to Public Resources Code (PRC), Section 50001(a).
- b. This permit is consistent with the standards adopted by the CIWMB, pursuant to PRC 44010.
- c. The design and operation of the facility is consistent with the State Minimum Standards for Solid Waste Handling and Disposal as determined by the local enforcement agency, pursuant to PRC Section 44009.
- d. A Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR 1-89) was filed with the State Clearinghouse (SCH #89052316) and certified by the Shasta County Planning Commission on June 7, 1990. The FEIR describes and supports the design and operation, which will be authorized by the issuance of this permit.
- e. A Negative Declaration was adopted by the Shasta County Planning Commission on April 10, 2008. A Notice of Determination was filed on April 21, 2008. This Negative Declaration describes and supports the design authorized by the issuance of Use Permit Amendment, UP-0024A. State Clearinghouse #2008032023.

14. Prohibitions: The Anderson Landfill, Inc. is prohibited from accepting the following wastes:

Hazardous, radioactive, medical waste (defined in Chapter 6.1, Chapter 20 of the California Health and Safety Code), liquid, designated, or other wastes requiring special treatment or handling, except as identified in current Report of Disposal Site Information and approved amendments thereto and as approved by the enforcement agency and other federal, state, and local agencies.

15. Documents that have been reviewed and determined to describe and/or restrict the operation of this facility. Should documents be amended, revised, or otherwise updated, approved documents that are more currently dated supersede these listed.

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16. Self Monitoring:

The owner/operator shall submit the results of all self monitoring programs to the Enforcement Agency within 30 days of the end of the reporting period. These reports shall be on-site and available for review.

a. The types and quantities (in tons) of waste, including separated or commingled recyclables, entering the facility per day.	Quarterly
b. The number and types of vehicles using the facility per day.	Quarterly
c. Results of the hazardous waste load checking program, including the quantities and types of hazardous wastes, medical wastes or otherwise prohibited wastes found in the waste stream and the disposition of these materials.	Quarterly
d. Summary of the Log of Special Occurrences and copies of all written complaints regarding this facility and the operator's actions taken to resolve these complaints.	Quarterly
e. Results of the landfill gas monitoring program.	Quarterly
f. Wet weather preparedness, erosion control, and winterization plan.	Annually – November 1
g. Remaining site capacity.	Annually – 2 nd Quarterly Report
h. Summary of groundwater monitoring and related reports.	Semi –Annual and Annual
i. Fill Sequence Plan	Annually -2 nd Quarterly Report

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17. Enforcement Agency (EA) Conditions:

- a. The operator shall comply with all State Minimum Standards for solid waste handling and disposal as specified in Title 27 and Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.
- b. The operator shall maintain a log of special/unusual occurrences. This log shall include, but is not limited to, fires, explosions, the discharge and disposition of hazardous or unpermitted wastes, and significant injuries, accidents or property damage. Each log entry shall be accompanied by a summary of any actions taken by the operator to mitigate the occurrence. The log shall be available to site personnel and the EA at all times.
- c. Additional information concerning the design and operation of the facility shall be furnished upon request and within the time frame specified by the EA.
- d. The maximum permitted daily tonnage for this facility is 1850 tons per day and shall not receive more than this amount without a revision of this permit.
- e. This permit is subject to review by the EA and may be suspended, revoked, or revised at any time for sufficient cause.
- f. The EA reserves the right to suspend or modify waste receiving and handling operations when deemed necessary due to an emergency, a potential health hazard, or the creation of a public nuisance.
- g. Any change that would cause the design or operation of the facility not to conform to the terms and conditions of this permit is prohibited. Such a change may be considered a significant change, requiring a permit revision. In no case shall the operator implement any change without first submitting a written notice of the proposed change, in the form of an RFI amendment, to the EA at least 180 days in advance of the change.
- h. A copy of this permit shall be maintained at the facility along with all documents as required by Title 27.
- i. The Anderson Landfill is authorized to accept municipal, commercial, agricultural, industrial non-hazardous solid waste, asbestos containing waste (friable and non-friable), titanium dioxide solidified with cement, cogeneration ash, dewatered sewage sludge, auto shredder waste, and petroleum contaminated soils, and other wastes as approved by the LEA for disposal.
- j. The Anderson Landfill is authorized to accept electronic waste, cathode ray tubes, metal, appliances, tires, and other materials as approved by the EA for recycling
- k. The current Joint Technical Document, dated March 25, 2008, describes the facility operations, plans, and supersedes any previously submitted documents.
- l. The facility must comply with Use Permit 00-24A conditions.
- m. The receipt, handling, and disposal of asbestos containing waste shall be in compliance with 14 CCR, Chapter 3.5.
