Many groups in California monitor water quality, aquatic habitat, and wildlife health to ensure good stewardship of our ecological resources. New! The [2026 Integrated Report Data Solicitation](#) period is now open! The 2026 Integrated Report will assess data collected from waterbodies in the North Coast, Lahontan and Colorado River Basin Regional Water Boards, and the San Joaquin sub-basin of the Central Valley Regional Water Board (please refer to [an interactive map of the Regional Water Boards](#)). To be considered for the 2026 Integrated Report, data must be submitted to CEDEN before the cut-off date of **October 21, 2022**.
