In 2007, the Air Resources Board reviewed the State NO<sub>2</sub> standard. As a result of this review, the State 1-hour NO<sub>2</sub> standard was lowered and a new annual standard was adopted.

There are now two State nitrogen dioxide standards, a 1-hour average of 0.18 parts per million and an annual arithmetic mean standard of 0.030 ppm. Both are not to be exceeded.
