Sunset Pumps –

- removal is still in planning phase, although there has been recent movement
- there is a potential funding source—US Army Corps of Engineers
- USACE would fund interim partial passage, but won't be doing full removal until much later (\$50 million project, so scrapped for now)
- The rock weir was recently rebuilt, so the ~4000 cfs minimum threshold to allow salmonid passage that she had suggested before is no longer valid

Shanghai Bend-

- washed out on its own and isn't an issue anymore
- breached in 2012
