I would say the 105 Native American sites are all a priority. I would use an analogy from emergency response to disasters; we don't like to say one disaster is more or less important or significant. All cultural sites are important. It would also be cumbersome to receive the data piecemeal.

In terms of sites with historical as well as prehistoric/ native american, we usually just have a /h at the end to signify that there are historical components as well. We don't need any other info for historical.

Hi, Andrew

Thank you for the enlightening discussion yesterday about your GIS needs. I talked it over with ICF and, while we cannot provide you with all of the data in all of the data fields for each shape file quickly, we can perhaps give you sufficient data for those attributes that are most important for your querying.?? For example, there are 105 sites that are Native American resources (about half also contain historic-era materials), but of those 105 sites, only six or fewer have recorded human remains.?? So it would be relatively easy to fill in the data fields for those few sites and get that to you.?? What other resource attributes would you be especially interested in having in the notes? Midden deposits, bedrock milling stations? If we can know your priorities, we can perhaps work more quickly to get the data you need.
